

**Tehama County Mosquito and Vector Control District**  
**Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting and Public Hearing July 14, 2021**  
**District Office 11861 Highway 99W, Red Bluff, CA, 96080**

President Hofhenke called the meeting to order at 12:02 pm with Board Members Etzler, Lindner, Mitchell, Turner and Wohletz. Also, present John Bliss of SCI, Ast. Manager Robinson, Technicians Larzabal, Church, Junge, Joseph and Manager Cox.

President Hofhenke asked for any public comment on non-agenda items. Mr. Wohletz expressed his belief all employees should be required to get vaccinated for Covid -19. The unvaccinated in Tehama County are endangering the public and don't understand the importance.

The minutes of the Regular Board Meeting on June 9, 2021 were then discussed. Mr. Wohletz amended the minutes in the last paragraph. Mr. Wohletz moved to approve the minutes as amended. Second by Mr. Turner. All ayes.

President Hofhenke closed the Regular Board Meeting at 12:05 pm and opened the Public Hearing to consider the Ordering of Services and Levy of the Assessments for Fiscal Year 2021-22 for the Tehama County Mosquito and Vector Control District (the "District") Mosquito, Vector and Disease Control Assessment ("Assessment No.1") and Mosquito, Vector and Disease Control Assessment for Formerly Unserved Areas ("Assessment No. 2"). No public was present for the hearing. Manager Cox recommended approving resolution 2021-02, approving the engineer's report and levying the assessments for the two areas. Assessment rates will not be increased in zone 1 and a 3% increase in zone 2. John Bliss of SCI gave an overview of what is occurring with benefit assessments in California and other issues. President Hofhenke closed the public hearing at 12:45 pm and opened the regular Board meeting.

Mr. Turner moved to adopt Resolution No. 2021-02 approving the Engineer's Reports, confirming the Assessment Diagrams and Assessments and Ordering the Levy of Assessments for Fiscal Year 2021/22 for Assessment No. 1 and Assessment No. 2. Second by Mr. Wohletz. By individual voice vote all present voted aye.

Operational activities have all employees in the field full time. Mosquito control activity continues with larvaciding and adultciding. There has been no WNV activity found in Tehama County. WNV has been confirmed in surrounding counties and 1 human case which was fatal in Southern California. The purchase of new vehicles will have to be delayed as all dealers have no ability to get trucks at this time.
